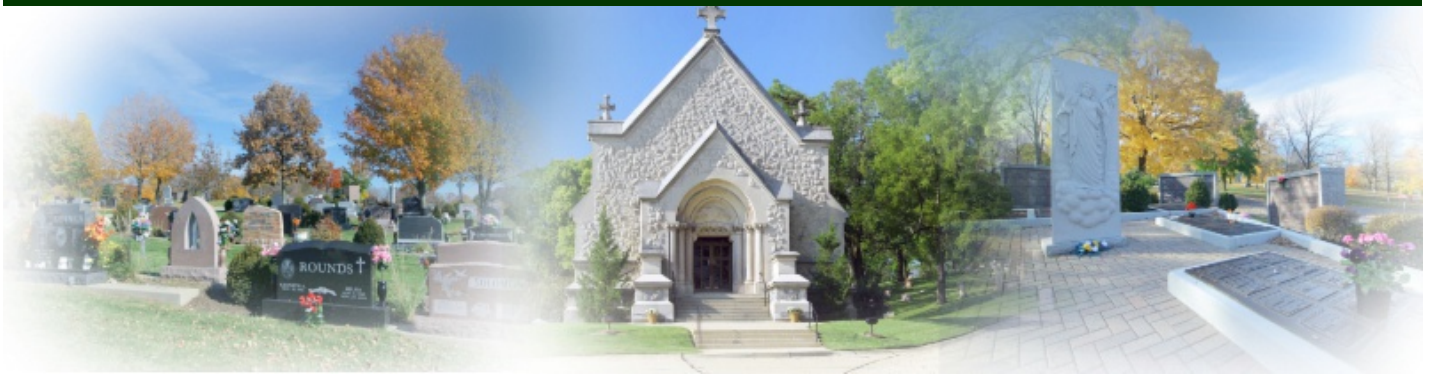

As the fall colors have arrived, we invite you to walk the grounds and tour the cemetery. As always our gates are open 7 days a week, 7:30am until dusk.

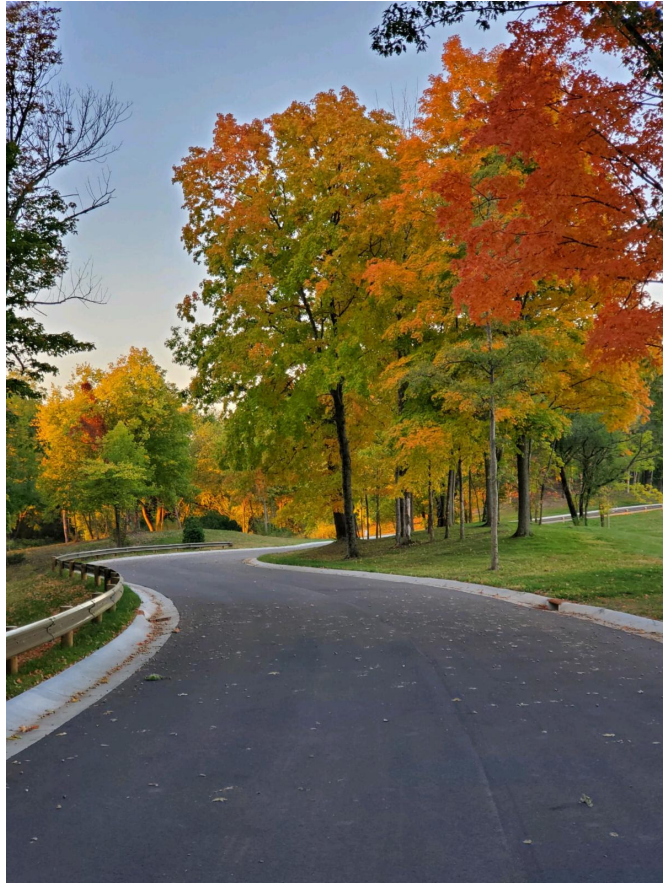

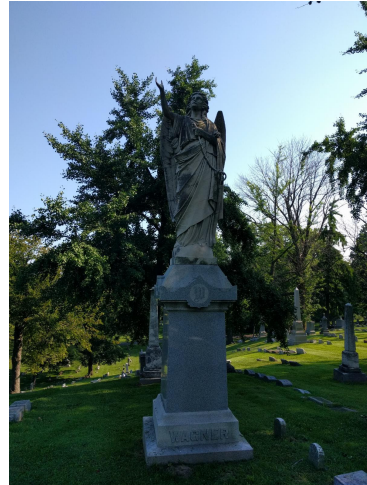
Unfortunately, due to Angel Night being a drive thru, we will not be open to walking tours during the event this year.

Lunch and Learn

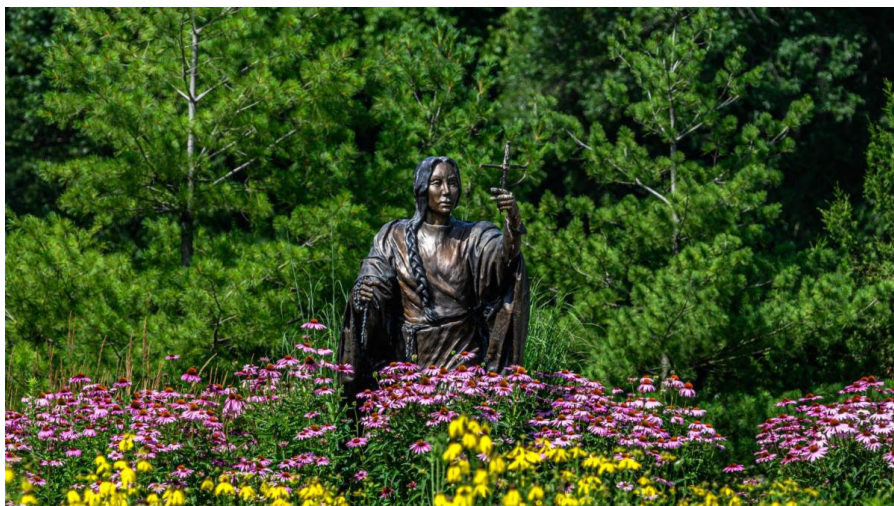
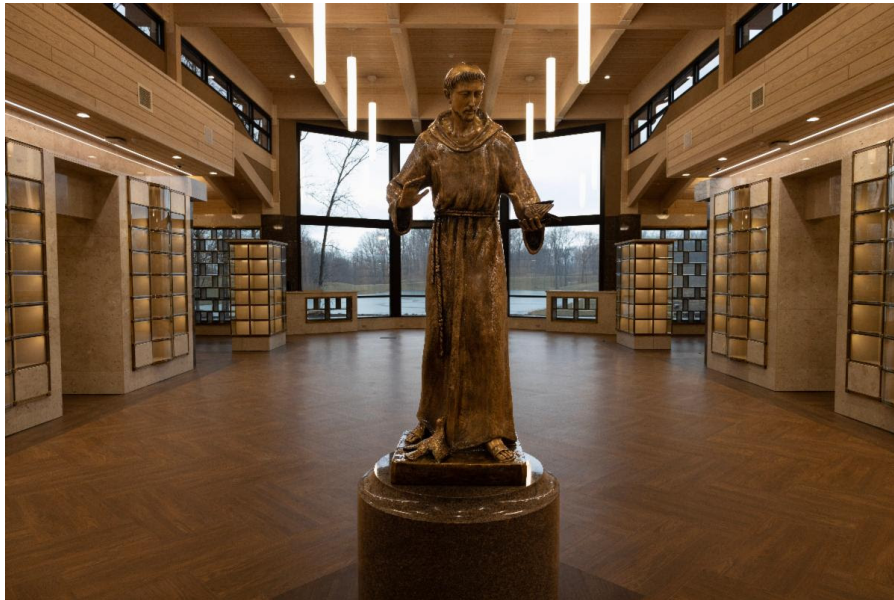
